Forecasted demand for natural gas in the Southeast United States, primarily driven by power generation needs to support the significant capital investments in Al-based data centers and large industrial loads, has seen a dramatic increase in the past 18 months. The purpose of the project is to provide gas supply needed to meet this growing demand for electric generation in Mississippi and the Southeast. The project will connect supply from the Haynesville, Utica/Marcellus, and Fayetteville basins to markets in the Southeast that are tied into Gulf South's existing system or served through new and existing pipeline interconnects. The project is designed to provide up to 1,175 Mdth/d of new gas transportation capacity to these end-use markets.

The project consists of approximately 110 miles of new 36-inch pipeline, six new compressors at new and existing stations, and new receipt or delivery meters at five locations. The project will create 1,175 Mdth/d of firm transportation capacity to markets in the Southeast.

LP, which is headquartered in Houston, Texas.
Boardwalk's leadership, officers, and project management
team have significant experience in designing, permitting,
and operating interstate natural gas pipelines and related
infrastructure. Boardwalk will retain appropriate
consultants to support the engineering, environmental,
and other work necessary to progress the project through
all stages of development and construction.

The project has strong market support, with binding agreements from three shippers for 1.1 Bcf/day of the total 1.75 Bcf/day in firm capacity, for a period of either fifteen (15) or twenty (20) years.

The project will not involve any Federal financing.

Summary of Financing, Reviews and Authorizations

convenience and necessity from the Federal Energy
Regulatory Commission (Dockets No. CP25–547–000 and
CP25–549–000) and other permits, authorizations, or
consultations required under federal including a Section 7
Formal Consultation (U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service),
Nationwide Permits under Clean Water Act Section 404
(U.S. Army Corps of Engineers), and Clean Water Act
Section 401 certification from Mississippi, as well as
additional authorizations from the Mississippi Department
of Environmental Quality, the Mississippi Department of
Wildlife, Fisheries, and Parks, and the Mississippi
Department of Archives and History.

Project Assessment

This project will require authorization and review by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission and will involve the construction of infrastructure for pipelines and associated facilities. The project is subject to NEPA, will require a total investment of more than \$200,000,000, at this time does not qualify for abbreviated authorizations or environmental review processes under any applicable law.
